

SUBJECT: Case MH D-2023-01 Sharp

On June 6, 2023, the State Building Code Office (SBCO) received a consumer complaint document from Linda Sharp (the homeowner). In the subsequent two weeks SBCO staff contacted all parties to discuss their views of the case. The Manufacturer (Champion Home Builders) refused to cover the cost of the repair in full and offered to split the cost of the roof repair with the installer (PB&J). The Installer stated that the home arrived from the factory with excessive shipping material stapling which damaged the home and that because they had notified the retailer of the issues with the roof from its packaging at the factory, they would not take responsibility for the damage. Both parties acknowledged the roof was damaged in some capacity because of the shipping materials. The homeowner alleged that both the installer and the manufacturer shared blame. The homeowner replaced the entire roof covering and is seeking reimbursement.

On June 26, 2023, the SBCO had an Informal Fact Finding (IFF) teleconference with Champion, PBJ and Sharp. All parties submitted documents to support their position prior to the IFF conference. SBCO staff reviewed the documents prior to the IFF to establish the line of questioning and our basis for a potential determination. The historical timeline according to the IFF and document submittals is as follows:

- o April 7, 2022 home purchased by Linda Sharp from Champion Lillington
- o April 17, 2022 home installed at Dragon Rd.
- April 24, 2022 April 4, 2023 service personnel from Champion went to the home at least 5 times to make cosmetic adjustments, realign doors and windows, and fix leaks in the roof.
 See files "sharpe sharpe5". The file "sharpe4" indicates service personnel were told to leave the roof in a damaged state as early as July 27, 2022
- August 24, 2022 service personnel from Champion acknowledged leaking in the dormer and made repairs to only that section of the roof.
- March 28, 2023 service personnel from Champion noted additional leaking damage in the roof and notated it was "nothing the factory had done. Looks ok!" and a comment was made on that item stating additionally "NOTHING A SET CREW WOULD HAVE DONE!!!!" (sharpe5)

On July 7, 2023, the SBCO filed a Notice of Determination that the Manufacturer, Champion Homes of Lillington, NC, had sole responsibility for the damage to the home. The basis for this Determination is as follows:

All parties agreed the holes in the roof originated at the factory. All parties agreed that there were staples that punctured the roof covering. The installer's responsibility when they discovered this fact was to notify the retailer (Factory Expo, a subsidiary of Champion Homes). The installer provided email exchanges that established the retailer had been notified within a reasonable timeframe. The retailer was purchased by Champion Homes of Lillington at the same timeframe as this case was unfolding. Champion Homes furthermore made direct instructions to their service personnel to ignore the damage to the roof when they made other service calls to the home. Champion Homes exceeded their authority in making their own determination of fault without utilizing the Dispute Resolution Process. Champion Homes bears sole responsibility for the roof damage because (1) it originated at their factory (2) they were duly notified (3) they deliberately instructed service personnel not to repair the roof in a timely manner that would have prevented further damage (case files attached).

On July 26, 2023, the SBCO received an email exchange from Jason Norris of Champion questioning the nature of the Determination. After a brief exchange, Champion stopped responding to the SBCO's inquiries into the Sharp case. To this date, Champion has not complied with the Determination.

The SBCO had internal deliberations subsequently to establish a basis for a Board case.

At the end of August 2024, SBCO staff reached out to Champion regarding the unresolved status of the Determination. Champion re-iterated their disagreement with the decision and insisted that the matter was closed, and no reimbursement would be made to Ms. Sharp. SBCO staff contacted the remaining parties to the case to alert them verbally that there would be a Board case scheduled for this matter.

This account is made in accordance with notes made contemporaneously and the case documents.







The roof shows multiple areas of nail pops, staples that are pushing out of the roof or were not securely fastened initially. There are other areas that show past "repairs" by sealing the rain channels with roofing cement and other areas that show the application of "Flex Seal" type sealant directly to the shingles. The roof vents and flue pipe flanges do not have adequate cover at the sides of the flanges and top of one. The ridge cap shingles are not installed correctly at the left end. The roof is leaking at multiple locations as viewed from the homes interior. Roof replacement is recommended. Once the shingles are removed, roof sheathing may require some repair. Have a roofer replace as needed to avoid further damage to the home.






Backfilling soil against the foundation at the low areas is recommended to help divert water away from the foundation and crawlspace. The addition of crawlspace wells may be needed at the access points to prevent water entry into the crawlspace.

The ceiling in the front of the dining room and front right bedroom show moisture in the drywall from roof leaks above. Replacement of the affected drywall and insulation is needed by a contractor. Fungal growth may be present in the attic space above (The attic was not accessible for inspection) Cost may vary and does not include mold treatment costs. Other areas at the ceiling light in the dining room and the walls above the inside HVAC unit reportedly shows water running down the walls and at the light fixture but did not show substantial moisture at the time of inspection but do show water stains and damaged wall paper.

The Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) is the HUD State Administrative Agency (SAA) for the Commonwealth of Virginia and the State Building Codes Office (SBCO) is responsible for performing all required SAA functions, as well as the administration of HUD approved installation and dispute resolution programs. The SBCO is also responsible for enforcement of the Virginia Manufactured Housing Licensing and Transaction Recovery Fund Regulations and the Virginia Manufactured Home Safety Regulations.

In accordance with 24 CFR § 3282.403, we are notifying you of a complaint on a manufactured home built in your state. Attached for your review is a copy of a Manufactured Housing Consumer Complaint received by this office on June 20, 2022, concerning possible non-conformances on a home manufactured or sold by your respective firms.





To the Manufacturer: Subpart I – Consumer Complaint Handling and Remedial Actions according to Federal Regulation 24 CFR 3282.404 (a) You have thirty (30) days from receipt of the information to carry out any investigations and inspections of this complaint. You then have 20 days to make a class determination per 24 CFR 3282.404 (b) Please comply with the following:

- A. Determine if notification and/or correction may be required.
- B. Determine if this complaint affects a class of manufactured homes.
- C. If you determine that notification, Item A, is required, then you must prepare a plan of notification and submit your plan to the SAA of the state in which your factory is located.

Manufacturers and dealers of manufactured homes in Virginia are required to take appropriate corrective action at the site of a manufactured home in instances of defects that become evident after delivery of the home to the buyer in accordance with the Virginia Manufactured Housing Licensing and Transaction Recovery Fund Regulations, Section 13VAC6-20-310.

The State Building Code Office held an informal teleconference to discuss this case on June 26th, 2023 with the hopes of remedying the disagreement between the homeowner, installer and manufacturer as to the nature of several issues with the home (see attachments). After a presentation of documents provided by all parties, the parties have elected to escalate this to a formal dispute resolution hearing in accordance with the Code of Virginia and at the discretion of the Manufactured Housing Board.

The NC Manufactured Building Division (MBD) has reviewed the documentation that the VA Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) provided regarding the Linda Sharp complaint case #MH D-2023-01.

After consulting with legal counsel and the board's attorney, it has been determined that this matter is not within the NC Manufactured Building Division's authority to recommend to the NC Manufactured Housing Board to take administrative action against the license of Champion Home Builders, Inc., license 44830 (hereinafter, Licensee). However, if a formal hearing is held in this matter and the VA Manufactured Housing Board finds that the Licensee is in violation of the Code of Virginia, please be sure to provide us with the final order so that we may review the matter to determine if the Licensee should be taken before the Board .

NCGS § 143-143.12(c) provides that: "Any buyer of a manufactured home who suffers any loss or damage by any act of a licensee that constitutes a violation of this Part may institute an action to recover against the licensee and the surety." I have attached the bond submitted during the period of June 30, 2021 to June 30, 2022 by the Licensee. Ms. Sharp may proceed to file a claim against the bond if she deems it necessary. Ms. Sharp may seek legal advice if she needs assistance with filing against the bond. It must be noted that I spoke with the installer, PB & J and they are of the opinion that the entire roof did not need to be repaired/replaced. However, the final decision for any payout of the bond will be at the discretion of the surety company.

I have included representatives of Champion Home Builders, Inc., Lillington on this correspondence so that they may be aware of the same. It is my hope this matter may be resolved without further action being taken.





Consumer Complaint of Linda Sharp. This Champion double-wide home is located at the address above with the HUD label in the subject line. The subsequent complaints are made within the said warranty period as prescribed the Virginia Manufactured Housing Regulations.

Note: For reference, The Manufactured Home Construction and Safety Standard (MHCSS) 24 CFR Part 3280 used by HUD section 3280.303 General requirements; subsection (b) Construction, All construction methods shall be in conformance with accepted engineering practices to insure durable, livable and safe housing and shall demonstrate acceptable workmanship reflecting journeyman quality work of the various trades.

At the request of the owner an onsite investigation was conducted on March 14, 2024.

Observations and complaint:

The complaints and observations are as follows.

The purpose of this inspection was not to confirm the specific issues alleged by the homeowner as those issues were addressed by the homeowner prior to alerting the SBCO.

I confirmed that there was evidence of water damage in the vicinity of the leading edge of the eyebrow (the first two windows to the right of the front door when facing it from the outside).









The two corners above show evidence of water damage (darkened color) in the area alleged to have had leaking from excessive nail punctures in the roof.

I confirmed that there is already visible evidence of wear and tear on this new home due to possible improper installation of finishing pieces of siding (see below).











Remarks:

Per the Determination submitted by this office in July 2023 and the Summary of Facts from August 2023, Champion took responsibility for damages along the dormer/eyebrow which may be responsible for the leaking in the areas indicated. Champion has denied and continues to deny responsibility for other damage to the roof covering that were alleged by the homeowner, her installer (PB&J) and the roofer she hired to repair the roof (Triple J Construction). Because the roof was already replaced, it could not be verified during this inspection. However, based on the documentation from the home inspection report commissioned by Ms Sharp, the testimony and photographs from PB&J and the testimony of Triple J there is sufficient evidence provided to the State Building Code Office that Champion caused damage to the roof covering at the point of shipping and is responsible for subsequent damages originating from that.

To Champion Home Builders:

In response to the points raised in the correspondence received this morning, July 26th, 2023:

- Champion feels they were not notified that the shipping materials damaged the roof.
 - Response: This acknowledges that the factory did install shipping materials in such a way that they led to damage to the interior of the home. Further, the retailer was notified. The retailer is physically located at the same address as the manufacturer and is now owned by Champion even though they were not at the time of the incident. Ownership conveys responsibility. Additionally, the factory was notified by their own subcontractor a few months after Mrs. Hurley notified the retailer, and the sub was then told, by Champion, to cease work and leave the job site.
- Champion found additional unplugged holes in the roof when their own sub returned, and those were repaired.
 - Response: Those holes are in the dormer, is Champion alleging that the water damage to the interior of the home was caused by the holes in the dormer? The SBCO is confident the damage to the home is far more extensive than what could possibly have been caused by the shingles over the dormer.
- Champion feels that they should have split the cost with PB&J Transport and Mrs.
 Hurley seems to have changed her mind at the teleconference.





 Response: If Champion and PB&J had a good faith agreement to come to a resolution, it stands to reason that one could have been found without the State Building Code Office getting involved. Both parties deferred to the State and we have made a determination.

In closing, per our letter dated July 6th, 2023, the State Building Codes Office has made a determination that Champion Homes is the sole party responsible for the damages made by water intrusion into the home. If Champion does not come to a resolution with the homeowner by August 7th, 2023 we will bring this case to the Manufactured Housing Board. If this case comes before the Manufactured Housing Board, additional fines and penalties may be assessed against the regulant.

The issues that the customer was having involved the way the shipping plastic on the roof was removed, and the staples either left exposed or the holes not sealed properly afterwards. We have contacted the set up crew that the customer hired, and discussed this with them. PB&J Home Movers indicated that they had already contacted Ms. Sharp, and that the customer had already made the repairs, and is seeking reimbursements for those repairs. PB&J is now, wanting Champion to help in the reimbursement claiming that too many fasteners were put in the shipping plastic and they could not cover all of them. Our management is currently in discussions with PB&J to retrieve an outcome in regards to the reimbursements.

We will keep you updated as we find out more.
