Income limits will be updated in Hancock **effective immediately and will remain effective until superseded**.

In accordance with Weatherization Program Notice 25-3, the State may use the LIHEAP limit of 60% of State Median Income (SMI) but not lower than 200% of Federal Poverty Income Guidelines. According to LIHEAP Information Memoranda 2025-02, the Virginia State median income for a family of four currently is \$139,167. Sixty percent (60%) of SMI is higher for households of 8 or less. For households of 9 or more, 200% of Poverty Income is greater.

60% of State Median

In accordance with 45 CFR 96.85, 60 percent of each State's estimated median income for a four-person family is multiplied by the following percentages to adjust for household size for LIHEAP: 52 percent for one person, 68 percent for two persons, 84 percent for three persons, 100 percent for four persons, 116 percent for five persons, 132 percent for six persons, 135 percent for seven persons, 138 percent for eight persons, 141 percent for nine persons, 144 percent for 10 persons, 147 percent for 11 persons, and 150 percent for 12 persons. For each additional household member above 12 persons, add three percentage points to the percentage for a 12-person household (150 percent), and multiply the new percentage by 60 percent of the State's estimated median income for a four-person household.

200% of Federal Poverty Income Guidelines

From the U.S. Department of Energy, WPN 25-3 provides the thresholds for families sized from 1 to 8 persons. For families with more than 8 persons, 100% of poverty level increases \$5,550 for each additional person above \$52,720. Therefore, for weatherization at 200% of poverty level, add \$11,000 for each additional person above \$108,300.
